The Missoula Downtown Foundation (MDF) closes out 2019 with some notable accomplishments. In addition to supporting Caras Park improvements, downtown décor and sponsorship of local downtown events (the upcoming Festival of Trees), the MDF had a prominent role in completing the update to the Downtown Master Plan. This plan offers a path to the continued growth and intentions of our downtown and the MDF will have a lead role in realizing this vision.

Continued support of the "Unseen Missoula" program and completion of the first Downtown Heritage Interpretive Plan also marked the MDF's achievements in 2019. Funded by a state grant and MDF matching funds, this plan complements the Downtown Master Plan by identifying ways Missoula can retain its "authenticity" in the face of current and future changes. In the coming year, Missoulians will begin to see greater coordinated efforts by public and private groups to "Connect Our Community" to the downtown.
