Hours: Flexible part-time schedules available with early morning, evening, and weekend work required

Position Timeline: Main work takes place between May 10 and October 10.

Overview & Function: This role focuses on the watering and upkeep of over 140 hanging flower baskets throughout Downtown Missoula. Ideal candidates enjoy working independently, spending time outdoors, and helping keep the downtown area vibrant and beautiful. Bring your headphones, get outside, and make a visible impact on the community!

Core Position Duties

- Routinely water all hanging flower baskets throughout the downtown district
- Complete assigned 4-hour watering shifts
- Morning shifts (May–October): between 7:00 AM – 11:30 AM
- Evening shifts (late June–September): between 5:00 PM – 9:30 PM
- Assist with seasonal tasks such as basket installation in May and periodic deadheading

Required Qualifications:

- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Reliable access to a personal cell phone for team communication
- Strong responsiveness to calls and texts during work hours
- Ability to work outdoors for the majority of the job (95%+ of the time)
- Ability to lift up to 80-100 pounds and work comfortably with heights

- Opportunity to work outdoors during Missoula's most vibrant seasons
- Hands-on role contributing to the look and feel of downtown

- High level of interaction with the Missoula community and local stakeholders
